

After being assigned to Graveyard Falls after a violent storm struck unearthing dozens of skeletal remains of teenage girls each dressed in a white dress and holding a candle, Beth found herself comparing her own abduction and her best friend's murder fifteen years earlier, and couldn't help but wonder if it was the same killer from all those years ago. After the horrendous tornado ripped through his town destroying almost everything in its path, sheriff Ian Kimball couldn't believe the horrific crime scene he was now confronting. Since Graveyard Falls survived the ramifications of two sadistic serial killers not too long ago, the "Bride Killer" and the "Butcher", Ian knew without a doubt that the town had another serial killer on the loose. Always believing that his step-father was innocent for the deaths for two local girls and the kidnapping of Beth Fields years ago, Ian was determined more than ever to clear his dad's name and to find the real perpetrator responsible for those crimes. When more girls go missing, Ian finds himself working with Beth to find them, and she was nothing he ever expected. With her anxieties and insecurities from her past mounting, Beth realized that these disappearances were somehow related to her own captivity so long ago, and as she worked side by side with Ian in their quest for the truth, she couldn't deny the rising desire she felt for her old high school crush knowing full well he felt the same way about her. Placing their unbridled passion to the side, they both decided it was best to put all their concentration on the investigation, but the closer they get to all the answers they beseechingly seek, nothing will prepare them for the shocking revelation they soon discover when the evidence leads them to the identity of the true killer responsible for creating all the evil surrounding the town, including themselves, and most importantly, the chilling truth of all the dead girls..... thank you..

This was a decent mystery novel; I'd already read the previous Graveyard Falls books (1 & 2) before starting this one - I bought them as a package - so I was familiar with the author's style and how she approached her characters. The writing itself was good from a grammatical standpoint (important to me), but the story itself was only so-so. Without giving spoilers, it's about one of the characters who appears in the first 2 novels (the sheriff) and an old acquaintance of his who was kidnapped by a serial killer along with one of her friends and mysteriously set free (her friend was killed). She grows up to be an FBI agent specializing in missing persons cases (for obvious reasons) and the story follows their quest to capture the same serial killer who kidnapped the

protagonist as a teenager. One caveat to "no spoilers" - this is NOT a procedural type of mystery; this is a straight story book, almost no forensics, which isn't necessarily a bad thing, but in the case of these novels, I think a bit more real-world police stuff would have lent credibility to the stories. Did that involve too much research? Too much science? I don't know, but I did find it lacking, which is why I mention it. The lack definitely pushed the stories more into the realm of romance novel-mystery rather than a serious mystery-mystery (the romance plotlines are in your face pretty much from the get-go). All 3 books were quick reads, so if you're looking for pleasant but not terribly cerebral weekend reading, this series will do the job nicely.

Beth Fields is an FBI agent now, but she started life as JJ Jones. Discarded, she runs away with another foster girl from an abusive situation, only to be abducted and witness her friend's murder. As a survivor, she carries a special burden. When multiple graves of young girls are exposed after a tornado, she's part of the task force called in to assist the local sheriff. Ian Kimball picked the law enforcement profession after his stepfather was wrongly convicted of kidnapping and murder. Fifteen years later, he's sheriff in his home Kentucky county. Convinced the girls in the exposed graves are the victims of a serial killer, he asserts his expertise when the head of the FBI task force tries to minimize his role. Paired with Ian, Beth struggles to stay focused and professional while working a case that may be related to her own abduction. Will memories of that terrible event now return? Is she strong enough to withstand them? Focused on the suspense, this story has just enough underlying attraction between Ian and Beth to stay in the romance genre. Be careful where you put this down late at night.

I won this Kindle e-book through a Goodreads giveaway. I'll admit to being a bit wary at first when I noticed it wasn't just a mystery, but also romance. Ugh! As I started reading though, the characters kept drawing me in and the romance was minimal. (Thank goodness!) What really rocked it for me was the whodunit. There was one sex scene towards the end, again ugh! But, I survived it! In the end though, it turned out to be an excellent story. I'd be willing to read more of Ms. Herron's Graveyard Falls books. Such a creepy dang place! I think I'll be skipping her romance novels though. Yep, I'd recommend this book and author.
