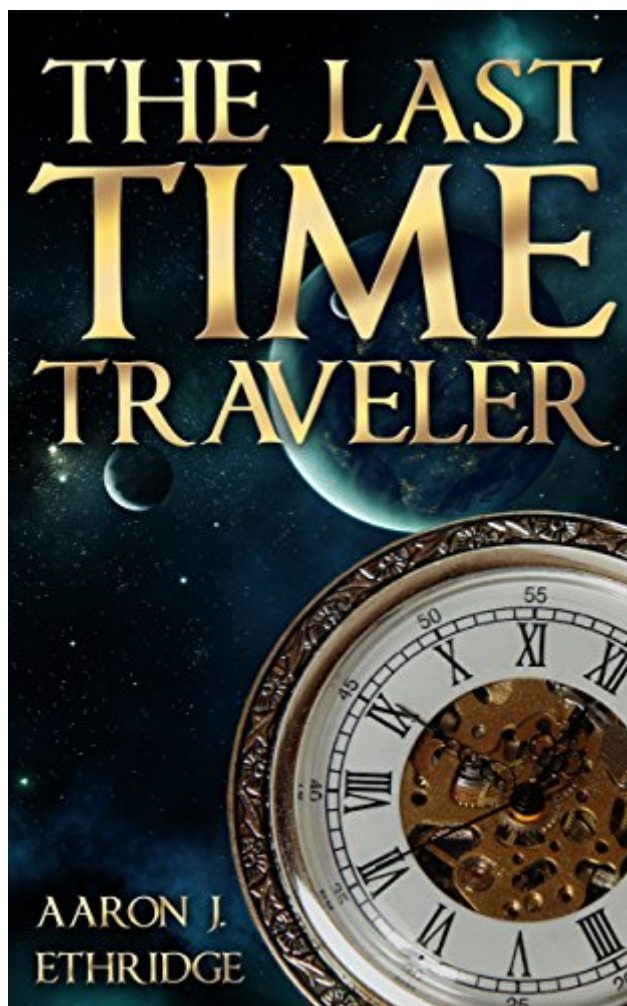

It features a quest to rectify mistakes made by other time travelers and avoid the impending end of time. I enjoyed reading the book and the several humorous spots. The characters include a blue woman, a green woman, a winged doctor. a young earth man; and a mechanic who do the time travelers bidding on their quest to set things right, or as right as they can be. Give it a try..
