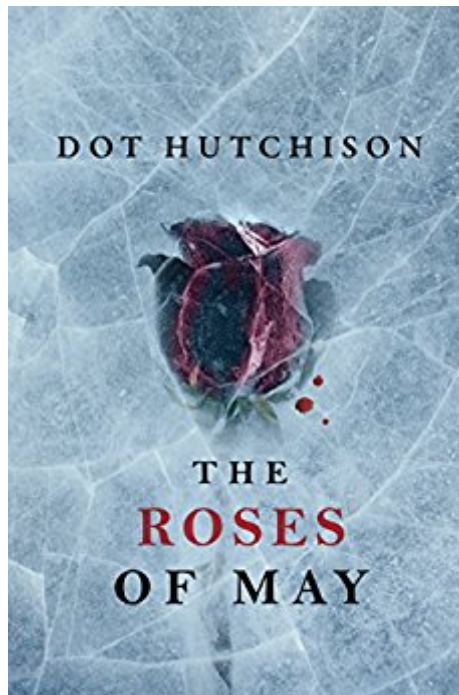




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The Roses Of May (The Collector Trilogy Book 2)
