

Remarks on clinical prognosis and treatment are also included. The emphasis throughout is on practical tips, common pitfalls, and the techniques used to obtain the best radiographs of specific areas and conditions. The latest edition of this text is a welcome addition to my reference library. I purchased the Kindle version so it is easily accessible for viewing digital radiographs in the field. I primarily use it on my iPad. The only cons to this edition which seem common to many Kindle books are the illustrations are not well marked. It is sometimes difficult to differentiate the chapter text from the captions on the illustrations/figures.
