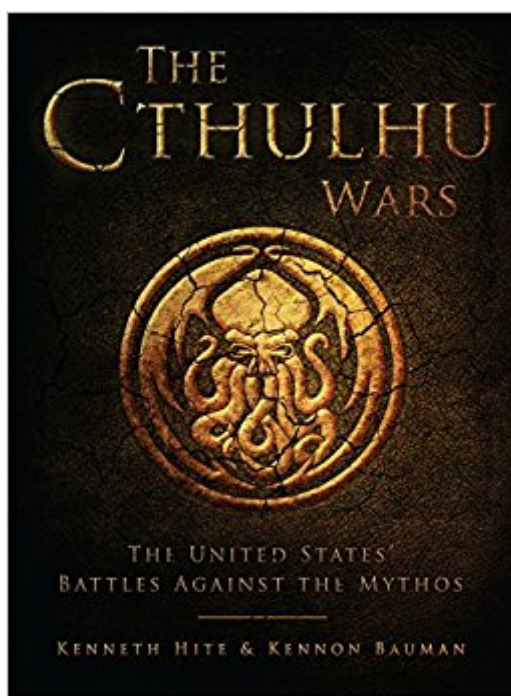




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The Cthulhu Wars: The United Statesâ€™™ Battles Against The Mythos (Dark Osprey)
