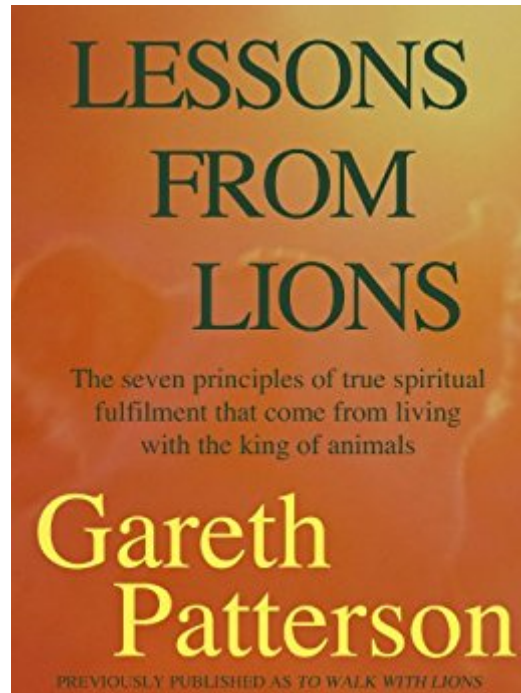

Lessons From Lions



Synopsis
