

I bought this for my anatomy class during the first year of medical school and found it to be a beautiful atlas and a good companion to anatomy textbooks. However, I found that some of the detail in the images was a little lacking, e.g. smaller vessels and nerves weren't labeled in any of the images. Additionally some part of the body were displayed from only a couple of perspectives, making visualization a little difficult. Overall, a good buy for an atlas with large, colorful images than you can physically carry around and look at (instead of staring so much at the computer screen), but definitely worth supplementing with 3D online resources and, of course, an anatomy textbook.

I really like the drawings in this book. They are very clear as to what the structure you are looking at is. Sometimes there are views I would like to see that aren't there, but it's still quite clear for a student level text. I'm currently in a grad level anatomy class and it is able to answer most of my questions and the remainder I can find with a google search.
