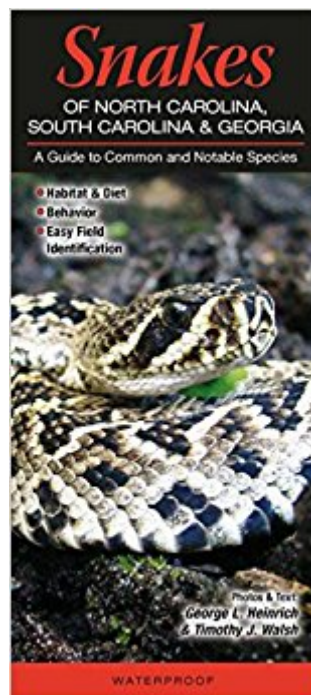

Every once and a while we would see one while we were on the trail and didn't know if it was poisonous or not. This pullout was a great solution. It is laminated, about 4 pages with color pictures.
