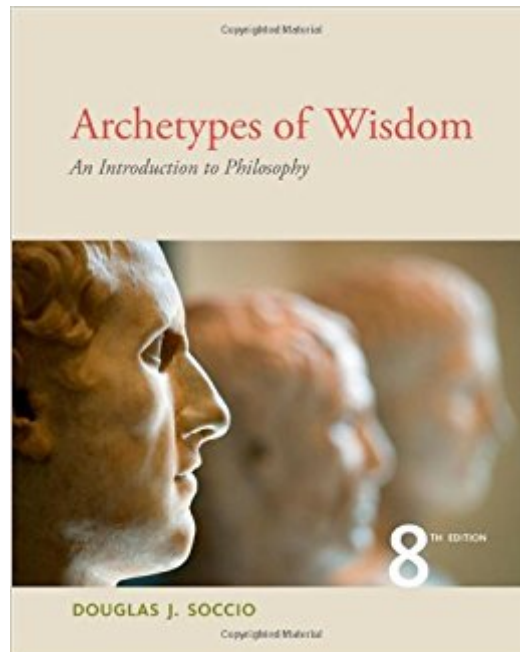




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Douglas Soccio was professor of philosophy at Shasta College for nearly 30 years. In addition to
