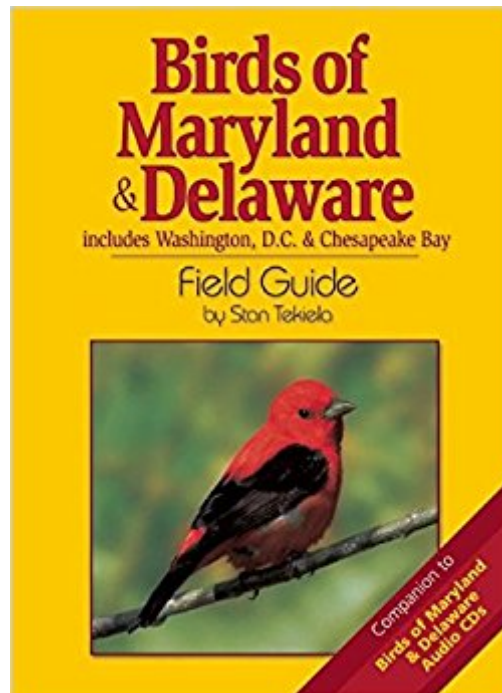

I am new to bird watching, and basically purchased this book to help me identify the birds that are visiting my bird feeder. It is a great size, smaller than the average book you buy, and I love how it is organized. All you have to do is flip to the section of the appropriate color that is most dominant in the bird! I also like how the females that are different, are listed separately so that you can look them up easily as well. Birds that have different plumage during different seasons are also listed separately so that it is always easy to look up a bird by its color. I have yet to know if it includes most birds, but so far...I haven't yet come across one I couldn't find in the book. I would recommend this book, at least for beginners! (more advanced birdwatchers might think differently)...

We love the way this book is organized --- when you see a bird, you look in the section that represents the primary color on the bird -- the photos have been great and we've been able to identify every bird that has come to our feeder this year. Great resource for identifying birds. Bought the SC version for my dad and he loves his, too.

I have had these field guides of different areas. This particular one is very good with pictures and descriptions.

Bought this for my wife who loves watching birds. She really appreciates the layout.

Having just moved to Maryland, we were curious about the birds that we were seeing in our back yard and at our feeders. A friend in Ohio showed me his edition, specific to Ohio, and I ordered this book on Maryland birds. Birds of Maryland and Delaware is a very (VERY!) easy to use guide for the casual spectator and the curious. We had been using a Peterson guide, but this book is much more helpful and uses photographs, rather than artist renderings. The color thumb guide also makes this a easy guide to operate. My five star rating for this book means that we have reviewed the book, like its writing style, have found the book exceedingly handy to use, and have no qualms about recommending it.

We got a bird feeder recently for the first time, and it was getting hard to discuss the birds with the kids, especially with someone that is part color blind in the family :) This book came in very handy. Mind you, it is a small handbook for a backyard bird watcher, not for an ornithologist. The color coding makes a lot of sense, and even my 6 yr old can find the bird in the book easily.

Most guides have so many entries that it is impossible for a beginner to use. My 6 year old granddaughter has been easily able to identify birds coming to my bird feeder with this book. As many have stated, it is organized simply by color with separate entries for male and female when needed. A few improvements would have made it a 5 star. - One of my neighbors was unable to find a bird that nests in his yard here in Central Maryland. It simply is not there. Missing a few birds? - So many entries for brown birds. Needs to be a way to break the category down more. Perhaps all brown, brown and white, etc. - Not sure why the hawks are listed so far apart in the book. red shouldered on p.179, red-tailed on 191. - Would be nice to have more views of the birds from different angles.

Great book for birdwatchers. It was a must have for our trip. We are all interested in bird watching and discovering some that we have not seen before is a wonderful feeling. This book was informative and very helpful. It is an excellent field guide for bird watching in Maryland and Delaware. I would make this purchase again if I needed another one.
