

Lanning and Bryner's 2004 book has been updated to reflect the new learning-skills standards of the American Association of School Librarians. The content focuses on core reference skills, electronic resources, and leadership. The first few chapters discuss information literacy, evaluation

of resources, the role of print resources, and the reference interview. These are followed by chapters on the library catalog, electronic resources, and the Web as a reference tool. Finally, there are several chapters dealing with the teacher-librarians™ instructional and leadership roles. The authors use a very accessible tone while providing the basics. A chapter on information-seeking behaviors would have been a good addition. However, for a simple introduction to reference services for teacher-librarians, this book does a satisfactory job. --Lesley Farmer
