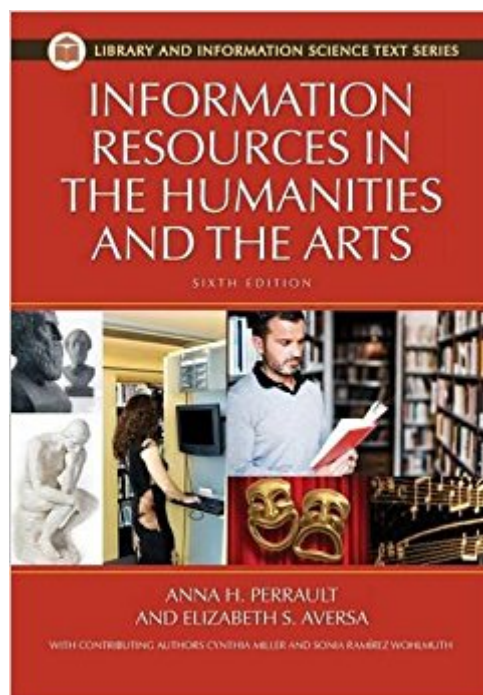


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Information Resources In The Humanities And The Arts, 6th Edition (Library And Information Science Text Series)
