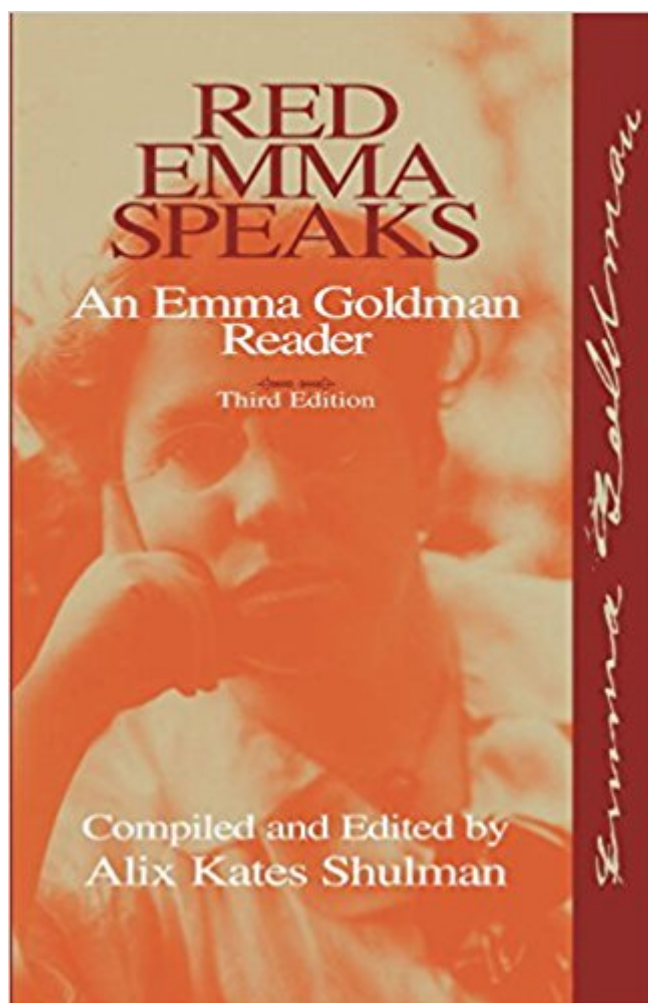

Red Emma Speaks: An Emma Goldman Reader



Synopsis

Unlike any other collection of Goldman's work, *Red Emma Speaks* presents in a single, handy volume the full sweep of her opinions and personality. In addition to nine essays from Goldman's own 1910 collection, *Anarchism and Other Essays*, three dramatic sections from her 1931 autobiography, *Living My Life*, and the afterword to her *My Disillusionment in Russia* (which the collapse of the Soviet Union later revealed as prescient), this book contains sixteen more pieces covering a great range of subjects, assembled here for the first time to offer a rich composite of Goldman's life and thought. Red Emma speaks on: anarchism, sex, prostitution, marriage, jealousy, prisons, religion, schools, violence, war, communism, and much more. This new third edition, containing a new foreword by Alix Kates Shulman and more accessible source listings, has been revised to situate the works more precisely in light of burgeoning Goldman scholarship.
