

I received this book in great conditions from the seller. It's actually not as heavy as it looks. Reading-wise, the chapters are longer than you would expect and is very dry to read.

Strickberger's Evolution The book is for sure very well produced and of high value. But I was really shocked as I noted that the Krebs cycle (page 169 in the fourth edition) is reproduced with lots of errors a novice would for sure struggle with this representation. What is unacceptable in my opinion is that the same error is also present in the former third edition (page 168). It is to hope that the evolution of this book in a 5th edition would lead to a much more trustable book.

I have not yet read the book and frankly I may not read it. I got this book for my 10 year old daughter, she likes biology books. I buy them for the illustrations. Generally they are beautifully illustrated, not this one. It is filled with wonderful pictures alright, but they are all black and white (or I should say the cheapest green and white). Why pay photographers to take such beautiful pictures and then short on the printing? Cheap Low budget, hashed together, this is on first review. My daughter still reads it though.
