

A rarity, all the books, listed by series along with dates in order. The highlight facility is great to keep a new author with several large series in order. Keep up the good work!

Every so often you run across an idea or an accomplishment or a service offered by someone that is so simple and forward that when you examine it, you slap yourself on the forehead and ask yourself, "Now why didn't I think of that!" And so it is with this little book list and the others in this series! Between my wife and myself we read well over 400 to 500 books per year; many of these books are novels and many are parts of a series by particular authors. Some of the series books have just a few published while others have dozens and dozens. We both have found, through many years of trial and error that many of these series books really should be read in order in order to enjoy them more; indeed, in many cases, to simply be able to understand them. Now this review is for the published books, by series, of the author James Rollins and is a good example of what the creator of this series has done for dozens of authors. These are simple list books which is precisely what we wanted. You get the name of the book, what series it belongs to and the date of publication. No summations of each book (thank goodness), no whistles and bells and no digging through useless information. Much of the information found in this book can be found via search engines on your computer. We have found though that quite often these lists are not kept up to date and truth be told, are a pain in the hind quarters to find and interpret at times. Also, unless you print the list you finally find, it is not portable. The list book in question is automatically updated as new books are published and the author has given simply directions as to how you update your book. The author has also provided simply instructions as to how to highlight each book on your Kindle as you read them. I like this portable aspect and all my list in one place rather than hauling a stack of paper to the library when I search for new books or, which happens in many cases since we have a small library, request a loan from one of the other regional libraries. I have yet to request a book they cannot find. Now you can make a point that much of the information in these list books are available for free on line and this is true. But truth be told, for .99 cents it is worth the avoidance of the hassle of searching and searching for information which is not as cut and dry as we found in these list books. As one reviewer has stated... "Best dollar I ever spent!" So true, so true! If you don't believe me, go search out a list on line for Agatha Christie and try to come up with a comprehensive list...try it with Terry Pratchett. Between my wife and myself we follow at least 30 plus different authors and their series...we do love these list books.

For me it was a pain to have to find the series on Wikipedia or wherever but now it's on my paperwhite. I have discovered that it's helpful to read the books in the order of the series also. Sure, over the years it has become a lot easier to find various series and make your own list by the publishing date, but to do all that to save 99 cents? Oh yeah, I forgot to mention that I have CRS. ;).

This is exactly what I have been looking for, but even better. I wish every author that writes more than 1 book would make a list like this. I just hate reading books out of order only to find that a main person in my new book was already killed off in a book that I read out of order. Thank you again. This list will get good use from me.
