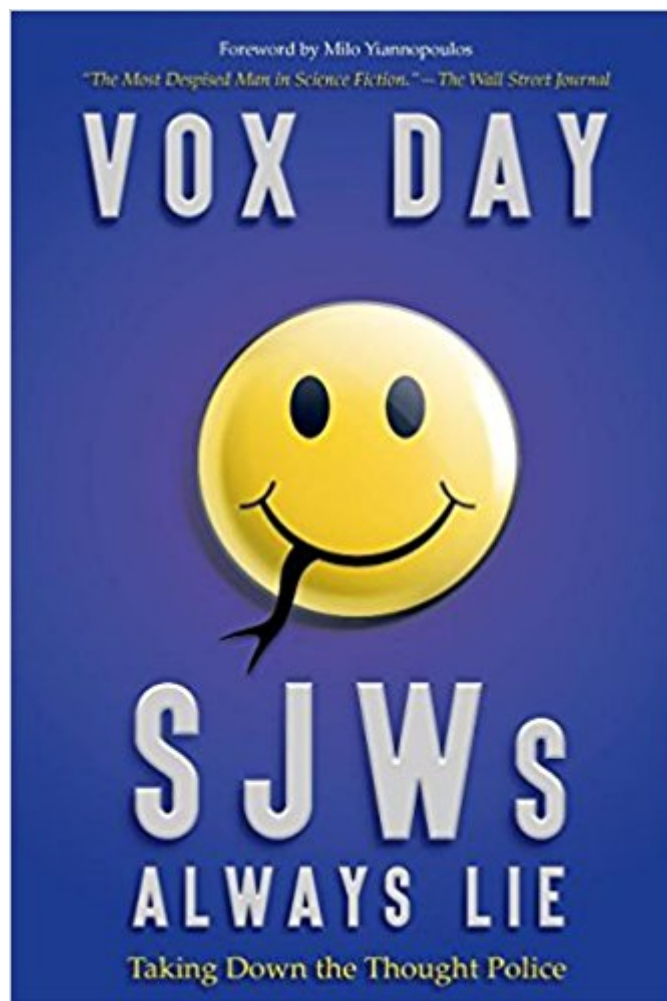

The book is named after the First Law of SJW: SJWs always lie. SJWS ALWAYS LIE is a useful guide to understanding, anticipating, and surviving SJW attacks from the perspective of a man who has not only survived, but thrived, after experiencing multiple attempts by Social Justice Warriors to disqualify, discredit, and disemploy him in the same manner they have successfully attacked Nobel Laureates, technology CEOs, broadcasters, sports commentators, school principals, and policemen. It analyzes well-known SJW attacks as well as the two most successful examples of resistance to the SJW Narrative, #GamerGate and Sad Puppies. Written by Vox Day, Supreme Dark Lord of the Evil Legion of Evil and three-time Hugo nominee who is described as the most hated man in science fiction by Black Gate and The Wall Street Journal, SJWS ALWAYS LIE is a powerful weapon in the cultural war against the thought police.

Loved the book - until roughly a year ago, I'd never heard of Vox Day, and only vaguely knew what GamerGate was - this book explains quite a bit about how SJW's operate (Read it, then read the one-star reviews, it's obvious that quite a few of them haven't read the book at all.) If I had Vox Day's reputation, I'd enter every public space playing Rob Zombie's version of "I'm Your Boogieman!" at top volume. This is a MUST READ if you work in a large corporation, by the way, because identifying the people who will lie, cheat, and steal to destroy you for simply existing and not agreeing with everything they say is an important skill to learn. I'm going to read this again, and recommend it far and wide. It gives me great joy knowing that this is money well spent.

I review this as an ardent anti-Voxer, who has argued with him many times. The man is a troll, a self-aggrandizing narcissist, and woefully ignorant of science. However, in the field of philosophy and debate, there are few better in this market. He understands clearly the tactical use of dialectic and rhetoric, and that arguing facts against someone who refuses to accept them is pointless. The key to arguing with such people is to recognize, evade, and turn their own tactics upon themselves, so they are forced into their own corners. And, may I suggest, it's very useful for dealing with annoying exes who attempt to obfuscate at every opportunity. It is well worth the money to learn how to debate with the unreasonable.

I can now recognize typical SJW behavior and am better positioned to avoid dealing with them in the future. I view this book as a self-defense manual.

I became familiar with this particular voice after discovering his blog during the 2008 crisis that leveled the industry I was employed in. I quickly read his Return Of The Great Depression which so

succinctly explained what happened and why and convinced me to make a midlife career change. I've followed with interest his calm and open assessment of the shrill class we now know as SJWs (Social Justice Warriors, and if you needed that explained then for your own sake you absolutely must buy, or borrow, or otherwise acquire a copy of this book). With an impressively focused energy and admirable patience Vox Day has articulated what this group is about, what makes them tick, and more importantly - the focus of this book - how they operate. My one criticism in this case is that he didn't bring quite the same flavor of humor that he did in RGD as well as the immensely readable Irrational Atheist. But that may be because 1. the more vile the subject matter, the less amusing even wry observations tend to be. And 2. SJW's are already almost too ridiculous to satirize. But that said, there is some rich amusement when the most notorious SJWs behave so perfectly by the numbers its as if they've they've been living in the author's laboratory and he's just pulling back a curtain and pressing buttons and saying "Now, you'll notice when I press this button here the rabbits will all run to that corner over there, form a pyramid, and then devour the smallest and weakest. See? Just like that."

There was a battle taking place and most of us had no idea. But we do now. And more importantly, we know it's not hopeless and the Social Justice Warriors are not guaranteed victory after all. Read it. Learn it. Even if you don't like the man, Vox Day has done you a service. And he's in the trenches with you. In fact, he was there before you were.
