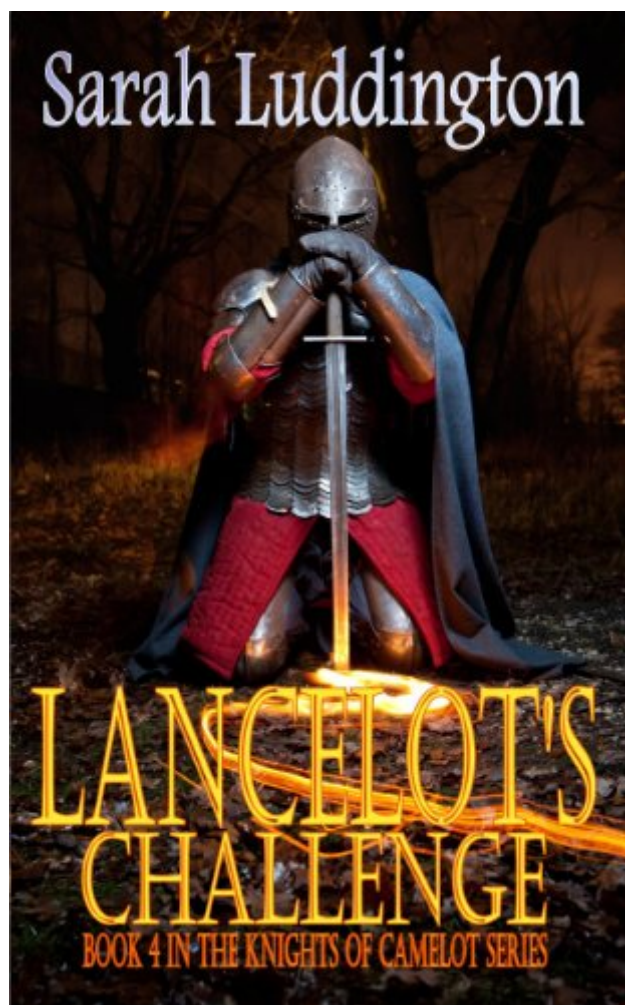

So, we have another book which had to be devoured. Lancelot returns again to defend Camelot as a threat has arisen. Arthur is wounded in battle and Lancelot calls out with his Fey blood for help, to the Lady of the Lake. Now, unlike the stories, the Lady is a stone cold bitch. There's no nice way to put that. She's cold hearted and greedy and flaunts her power. She has no love for Arthur and apparently despises anything sexual. She is the cousin of Nimue and she wants the throne. She intends to use Lancelot to get it. So she heals Arthur in exchange for Lancelot's service of a year and a day. She has him retrained to fight for her as her champion to win her the throne, determined to turn the Fey race into prudes apparently. Lancelot has no choice, as if he defies her she can immediately kill Arthur. So he takes up an enchanted sword of his own and goes to fight for the Lady. He is reunited with Tancred, whose relationship with the full Fey apparently didn't work so well, as Lancelot's half brother doesn't understand the concept of monogamy. Together with Morgana, they hatch a plan to keep the Lady off the throne and insert Lancelot instead. Of course, it's never simple and Merlin has his hands in things again. So just when Lancelot thinks he'll have peace as ruler of Albion and no longer under Arthur's influence, he's given a mission from the actual gods themselves to lead us into the next story. FYI, I don't much like Tancred at the moment. Yeah, he's supposed to be the better match since he can give stability but his insecurity irks me, and his reasoning for leaving Rafe, Lancelot's brother, would personally make me punch him in the face. Oh, so you don't like being abused and somewhat discarded. Gee, what the hell did you think would happen with a full Fey being given power over you, moron? Also, I'm hoping Merlin takes a bit bigger of a role in coming books, simply because I'm partial to the Merlin character and want to see what he can do. I can't wait to get to the next book.

This is the fourth book in this series I've read and I read it all through the night. I could not put it down. I was shocked when I finished it and saw the sun coming up! It is that good. We first get a glimpse of the Lady of the Lake when she presents Arthur with Excalibur--well this is a whole new Lady! Cold, calculating, and she put the Victorian in England! Nevertheless we get our first glimpse into Albion. This is where the "Mists of Avalon," series hints at, the world of the fey, the mystical magical and not always so nice creatures that torment Lancelot and the people of his day. Arthur plays a minimal role in this book in only that if he doesn't fulfill this particular challenge his king will

die, but this is solely Lancelot and his growth, this is where I really see him honing his skills for the rest of the series. Tancred reunites with him here and you know that the next book will be a journey that will involve them. The epic continues...

This 4th book in the series doesn't disappoint. The challenges, both emotional and physical, that Lancelot faces are like never before. The story between he and Tancred develops more and I was left with an eagerness to start the next book, to see where the story goes now. If you haven't read the other books, you should definitely start them immediately. I would recommend buying Lancelot and the Wolf (and other short stories) - Stonewall edition. The short stories included give more insight into some of the relationships throughout this series.

Poor Lancelot is set off on another near impossible mission because of his love for the king. He is owned by the lady of the lake for a year and a day. She has him trained to be an even more powerful killing machine so he can win her the crown of the fae. Tancred is back and stronger than ever in this book. I love this story and cannot wait until the next one comes out. I will be rereading this series. I don't think I can ever get enough Lancelot in my life!

I loved the 'story' but I just wasn't ready for a gay King Arthur and Lancelot. I'm an avid Arthurian and have traveled across England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales in search of the sites of Arthurian legend and have been to Tintagel, Hadrian's Wall, Stone Henge and too many other sites to mention.. so this rendition of King Arthur, Lancelot and Guinevere really threw me although the 'adventure' was quite grand.

I was shocked with where this book went, never saw it coming! New characters that really make the Knights of Camelot world turn upside down! Fantastic story! Great writing!! Makes me want to start fencing! Lancelot is the man!
