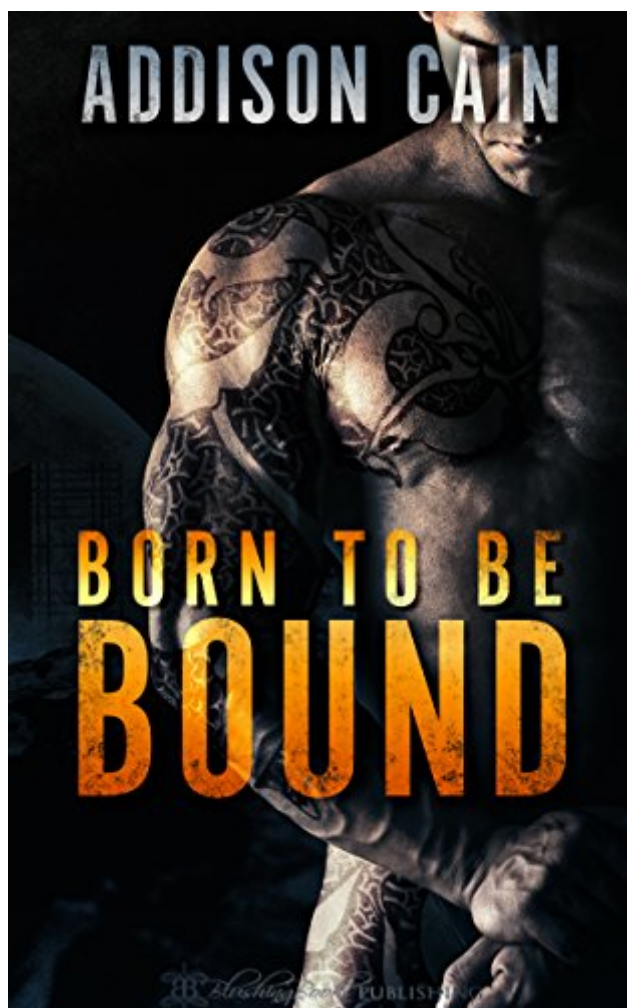


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Born To Be Bound (Alpha's Claim Book 1)

And Shepherd vows he will hunt her down Ã¢Â ready to burn the city to ash if he has to. Because Claire is his. His mate."), 3) it's not a sappy, happy, problem free romance (yet, in my opinion it's not overly depressing), 4) it's not purely a romance story as it also deals with other issues such as war, ethics, humanity, and others; also, it's set in a sort of science fiction post apocalypse world where the characters are either alphas, betas, omegas, and so on. I will be reading the rest of this series as I have enjoyed this book and want to see how it plays out. Lastly, I did receive an ARC for an honest review and this is my honest review; also, even though I do have an ARC copy, I did purchase the book because I enjoyed it enough to buy it and support the author.

Wow. I mean, wow. This is the kind of dark, hot writing that makes me stay up WAY too late because I can't put it down. Addison Cain's fast-paced, erotic writing left me breathless from beginning to end. Not only does she weave a totally new kind of shifter story together in this incredible world she has built, but she somehow makes it both blisteringly sexy and deeply emotional at the same time.
