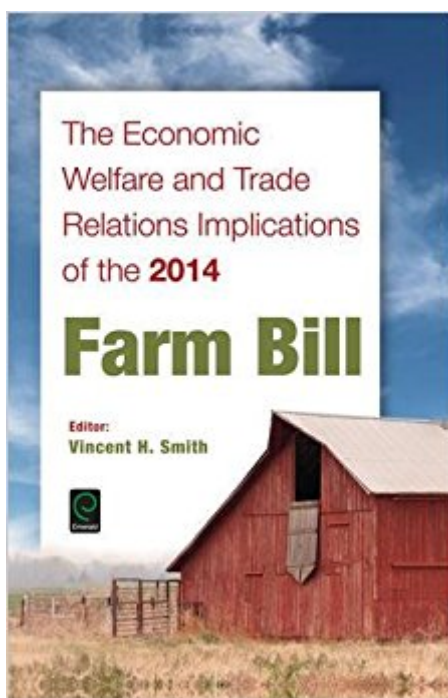


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The Economic Welfare And Trade Relations Implications Of The 2014 Farm Bill
