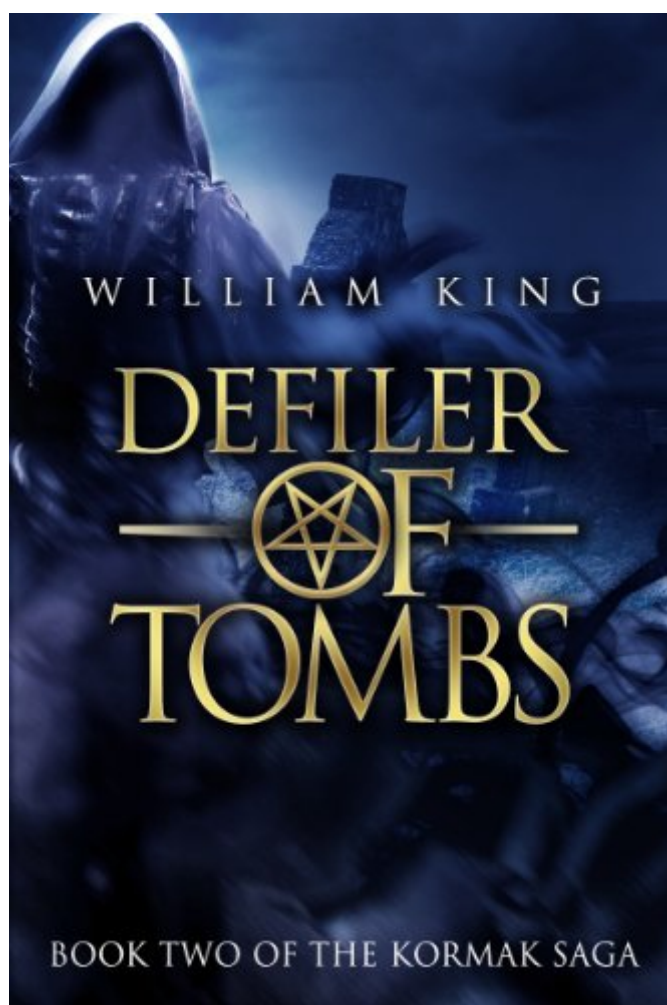

Another good Kormak book. Entertaining as usual, and with some interesting world-building.

Another wonderful sword and sorcery story by a great author. Kormack is a hero in the classic sense of Conan, Soloman Kane or John Carter of Mars (the books not the movies). I had anticipated this book for some time as Mr. King had mentioned it in his blog but had been afraid that I would not see it for some time. It made a great diversion from the holidays. I only regret that I will have to wait again for another such story. As far as the story goes I love that it is the classic adventure story. A hero (Kormack) must stop a evil sorcerer from awaking a monster that could destroy the world as we know it. The characters are well drawn and the author gives very little away about the motives for the those who join the hero on his quest. I love that as it makes you want to know more about the individual and does not make them just cannon fodder for the monsters. Again a wonderful book and I hope he writes more for this character.

Not the best, and gets a bit boring in the middle. Towards the end it takes off and hooks you in though.

This novel is much better than the first in the series, hopefully it is a trend that continues, two novels left to read and the only complaint with this one is minor grammatical errors.

I've enjoyed this series, and this author, very much. I'll stack it up against Game of Thrones. I think it would play every bit as well on the screen. Kormak is a classic character.

This book is exactly what I've come to expect from William King. Its a fast paced, fun read with great characters. King doesn't disappoint!
