I liked the final installation in the series a bit more than I did the sixth book as this one didn't have Cas whining so much. I don't think I even remember her whining although Ridge is missing ... Also, Bhraava Saruth was a hoot and I adored him. If only they had found him sooner ... In addition, I found myself liking Therrik even though he was so unlikeable in the previous books and I was quite

convinced that I'm going to hate him forever but he managed to redeem himself in my eyes. There were basically three storylines. One about Ridge and his journey back to the capital. The second about Sardelle not believing Ridge to be dead and heading off to the mountains in order to find him. And the third about Cas, Tolemek, and Kaika on a mission that put them all in grave danger (I wouldn't have it any other way). There were parts about Ridge's storyline that I quite enjoyed, there were parts that I found rather predictable and there was also this one part that I, like a lot of other readers, was not a fan of because I thought Buroker could and should have handled it a bit better. I think I would've found Sardelle's storyline super boring without Bhraava Saruth along for the giggles as he definitely made that part of the story more intriguing. Also, the giggles he provided were most definitely appreciated. The final storyline had most action to it and may I say it again that I love Tolemek? I also felt that our explosions-fanatic Kaika added to that storyline and she and Tolemek together were just lovely. It's a pity that we didn't get Kaika's POV.

Everything that you thought could never happen to the main characters does. The dragons have been turned loose and they are vying for dominance over both warring nations. An awakened evil, manipulative witch, has come to claim Ridge as her own and the nation he loves as his own. Her soul blade has his energy from a very strong wizard, Bhraava Saruth, not even Jaxi can defeat him. Cas no longer has the dragon killing sword, Therrick does. The worst thing is Ridge has had his memories totally block and he no longer remembers. He is totally controlled by the witch. Sardelle cannot even sense where he is, if he is even alive. The rest of the team was sent to a very remote island to kidnap the Cofah king. They land in a swamp filled with strange creatures. All seems lost until Tolemek's sister and her dragon appear. then they make a mad dash for home with the Cofah on their tails.

An enjoyable and exciting conclusion to the series, with action on several fronts: Cas, Tolemek, Tylie, Kaika, Pimples, plus a couple more characters on a mission to kidnap the Cofah emperor (which of course doesn't go as planned); Sardelle and Jaxi's search for Ridge (or his body), with the contentious help of an eccentric dragon and the magic-averse Therrik; Ridge's confusion as he tries to get back (no spoilers), ...Brava Saruth is fun (much more than Phelistoth), and I wonder if we're going to get to see more of that bookish foreign princess some time. Though I agree with some other reviewers that what happened with Ridge is handled a bit too lightly, I guess I too am guilty of being able to let it go. At least blaming oneself for what was done under mind control of one sort or another doesn't drag down this story as it did much of the last. Dragons can be awfully destructive,

though, and so can sorceresses.

I would LOVE more stories in this world!!! You just introduced too many new characters in Soulblade and we need to know what happens with Tylie and Wreldad! Not to mention baby Ridgewalkers and heirs to the throne!! I have thoroughly enjoyed the series and Soulblade is a superb balance of action, romance, and intrigue. Excellent plot and interesting characters. Terrific world-building, word-crafting, and (I am pleased to say) editing!! Would recommend to any fantasy/magic/dragon lover from young adult up. A few too many sexual situations, though not terribly explicit, for younger readers. However, for the intended age group, the romance would fall flat without them.

I thoroughly enjoyed this series, the first 3 free, but I could not wait until the next ones and bought them straight away, since then, I as a compulsive bookworm, have read all of them, stopping only for sleep and nourishment (and the occasional bit of cleaning, when my eyes got tired). These stories are well written, sonsequative and easy, even for a Younger viewer not to get bored. There are not hundreds in the cast of characters so this also makes for ease of keeping with the story. I have given it a full rating because it was totally enjoyable, however if you prefer death, horror, destruction and soft porn, read something else.

I've read all of Buroker's books, so I have trouble, now, coming up with new ways to say "fantastic, incredible read". But, it is a fantastic, incredible read. I thought that nothing could top the Emperor's Edge series, but this one is just as good. Buroker writes hysterical, laugh out loud dialogue, and dreams up unique, but believable, plots and worlds. She writes (along with other books under a pen name) stories that vacillate between science fiction and steampunk. It's hard to pigeonhole her work. Nevertheless, her books are among the most addictive out there. You will be sucked up and never let go of, that I can assure you of. This series ends with a bang, not a whimper. Everyone is mostly happy, and those who are not probably have their own series coming up. Don't hesitate to buy all of them, and then sit back and enjoy one of the most original set of books you've read in a long time. 5 Starts. Always.
