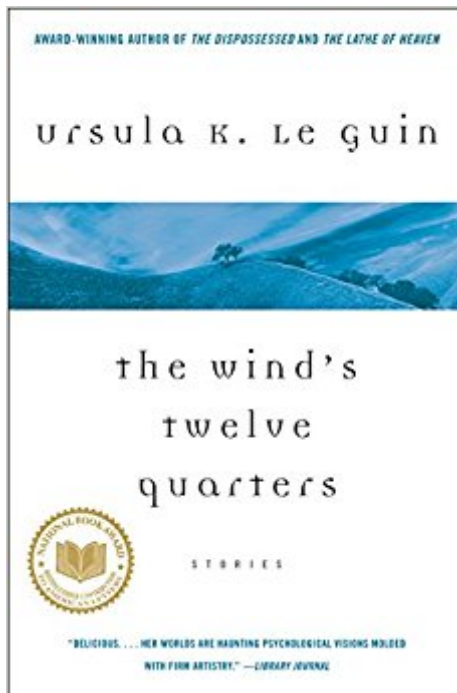




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The Wind's Twelve Quarters: Stories By Le Guin, Ursula K.

Ursula Kroeber Le Guin was born in 1929 in Berkeley, and lives in Portland, Oregon. As of 2014, she has published twenty-one novels, eleven volumes of short stories, four collections of essays, twelve books for children, six volumes of poetry, and four of translation, and has received many honors and awards, including the Hugo, Nebula, National Book Award, and PEN/Malamud. Her most recent publications are *Finding My Elegy: New and Selected Poems* and *The Unreal and the Real: Selected Stories*.

This is a collection of short stories by one of the more creative writers I have ever had the pleasure

of reading. LeGuin managed to create real aliens, not humans dressed up with tentacles, green blood or other weirdness. Her writing is good and her ideas original. Even if you don't normally read sci-fi or fantasy, I recommend this book to anyone who wants to challenge the way they look at things and enjoys good writing.

Speculative fiction short stories are hard because you have to catch on to the world being described in order to understand the story. I had to read some of these twice to catch on. But they are beautiful stories once you get them. A plus is commentary from LeGuin that precedes each story.

Got this for the Earthsea-related short story in it. While Ursula can get a little encyclopedic at times, this one is fabulous cover to cover.

The collection of stories was very diverse and encompasses many different worlds created by Le Guin, including tidbits of Earthsea. Her command of language and simplistic style makes the readers experience both exciting and non-tiresome. I would recommend this to any fan of sci-fi or fantasy. Truly a fantastic collection.
