Cherrie has had a rough life. Raped by her stepfather repeatedly, was a man's mistress who wasn't

nice, then kidnapped by a rival club and almost sold. Now she's a stripper at Dream House, the Insurgents strip club. Jax is sergeant in arms and has had a hard on for Cherrie since he first laid eyes on her but she wants nothing to do with men. He removes her from the stage because he doesn't want her stripping and that enraged her. How is she gonna to make enough money to get out of this town? They finally have sex and then she goes to work to find another stripper on his lap. She is furious and won't let him explain or give him another chance. She befriends an older member but he's more friend than lover. When her past comes back to haunt her and she is kidnapped, Jax will do anything to get to her back even go against the brothers. I hate how they treat women. But the stories are so addictive. Rough sex. Suspense. And a totally badass biker and a stripper trying to make a better life for herself.

I liked Jax and Cherri's story. Cherri was rescued by the insurgents in the first book from a rival club. Jax felt something for her even then and kept her around even if it was stripping at the Dream house. As their story progresses though they both try to get each others attention by making each other jealous. When Cherri and her daughter are kidnapped is when Jax realizes he is in love with her. My one small complaint I have is I wish to find out as the series progresses is how the prior couples are doing. Other than that this series is awesome. I hope the author never stops writing.

Cherrie's trying to put her life together after being rescued from certain death at the hands of a serial killer (Hawk's Property, Insurgents MC #1). She doesn't have time for Jax's attentions. Jax doesn't take kindly to Cherrie's refusal of his "affection". Toss in a jealous wanna-be girlfriend and an ex-sugar daddy for extra tension. This book takes us again into the underworld of bikers. A little less graphic than #1 with the "house parties" but no less intense in the emotions that are stirred up by the heroine's struggles. I only wish there was more detail written about the folks who eventually turned up missing and that a couple of others did so as well.

I loathed Cherri. I know she had a rough life and she was young and homeless when she made that fateful decision regarding McFahey, but damn does she ever learn her lesson? Poor Gunner, and playing dangerous games with Jax, and all he lost because of her made me sick. I felt she was dishonest, spiteful and STUPID. Jax deserved better and not Peaches. She got what was coming to her. The writing was great, I just couldn't get past Cherri.

Wasn't as good as the other two books I've read by this author. I didn't like Jax at all so it was hard

for me to stay interested in this story. He was a bully, a troublemaker, and just plain gross. Cherri was a messed up young girl that unfortunately, fell for this messed up man.

I liked the characters and the storyline better in this book than I did the first one. My gosh Cherri has had a horrible life. I don't want to spoil anything but thank goodness she had something to live for. Jax and Cherri both act immature a lot with making decisions without talking and listening to one another.
