

The Mission Earth Dekology is a tour de force, an amazing, almost serialized narrative story which is always moving and has twists and turns. It is indeed hard to put down as it's an easy read and engaging story. Definitely has good guys vs bad guys, but unique in that it's the bad guy narrating the story. You get inside his head and see the world from his viewpoint - even while rooting for the good guys. The subject matter and basic premise are to save Earth from itself due to greed and pollution. Interestingly enough the author gives credence to climate change due to pollution and global warming with scientifically factual data in a book written in the early 1980's. Ahead of his time! But, of course, Earth is on a self-destructive path and this series is completely applicable to current times.
