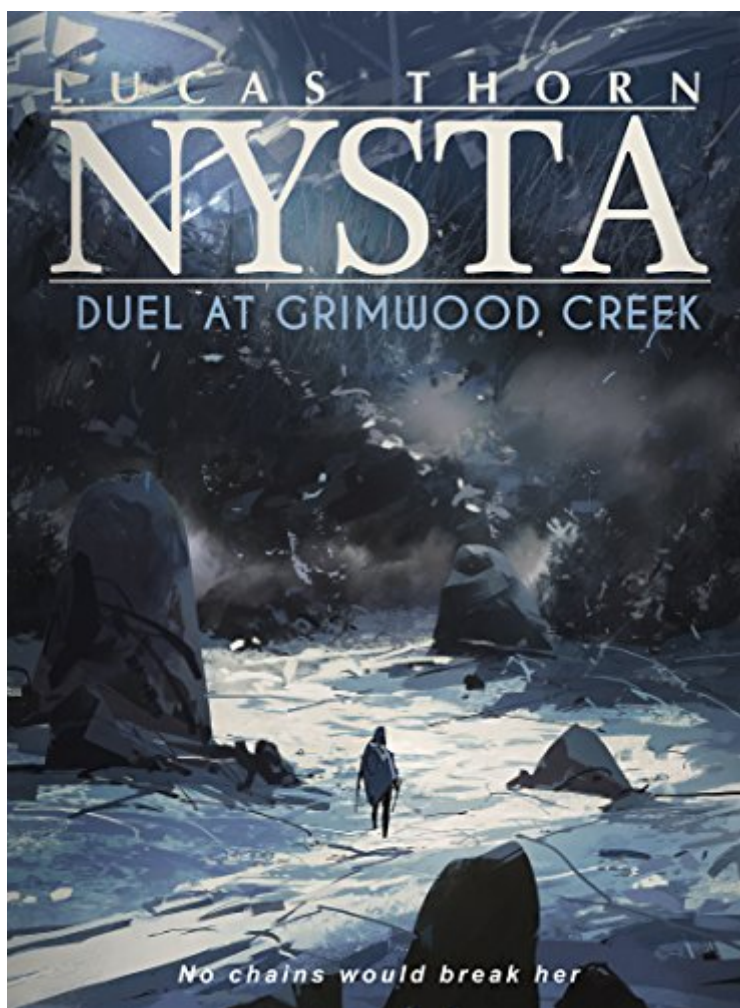


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Duel At Grimwood Creek (Nysta Book 2)

So this book and the first could've been put into one book - and usually what happens is that the plot gets stale. But not here. I very much enjoyed the tempo - it didn't once feel like I had to force myself to read (like I do with many other fantasy books). Most importantly it didn't feel like the author was just buying time - the plot progressed and most importantly there were a lot of scenes which would probably have been cut out otherwise. As a side note I want to say that I love how there aren't any long monologues where a character describes the history or mythology of the world. Unlike other books where there are entire chapters of this 'history book style' exposition, here we learn everything about the world through action. What magic there is and how it works, what groups and factions there are etc. Summarized - this is definitely worth buying if you enjoyed the first.

I have reviewed Nysta #2 and #3 together, but they really do deserve some additional - and separate - kudos. The more I think about this story (as I wait impatiently for the next books, *cough cough*), the more I am impressed by what the author is doing here. It's a High Fantasy plot with an ingraining of Western, Steampunk and straight-up Revenge Spree. I see complaints that there is a lot of swearing in this, and also that there is violence. Although there's not so much complaining about the violence. I guess words really can hurt some people. So get your security blanket out and read these books and tell 'em Hindle sent you.

Not your typical elf, she's troubled, twisted and brutally honest at times, not only with her words but her actions as well. The story is gritty and wonderful and I especially love that the author tells you at the foreword that the Nysta series is going to be a long one. Hurrah, long live the long lived series! I can't wait for the next installment!

Nysta is a great character, kind of like a Dirty Harry in that she's more than willing to get her hands dirty. She's very prickly though, and can be hard to warm up to. The warlock, Chukshene, is an ambiguous character who isn't completely on the up and up, but has his own strengths. All in all, a satisfying book that's part of what's becoming a very good series. (I'm glad I'm not completely

caught up yet!)
