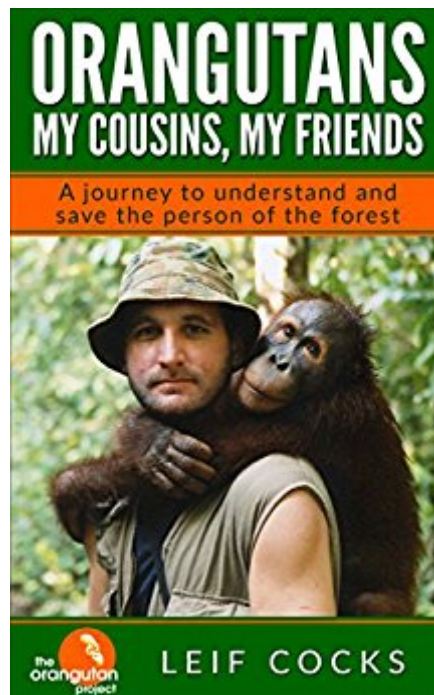




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Orangutans My Cousins, My Friends: A Journey To Understand And Save The Person Of The Forest
