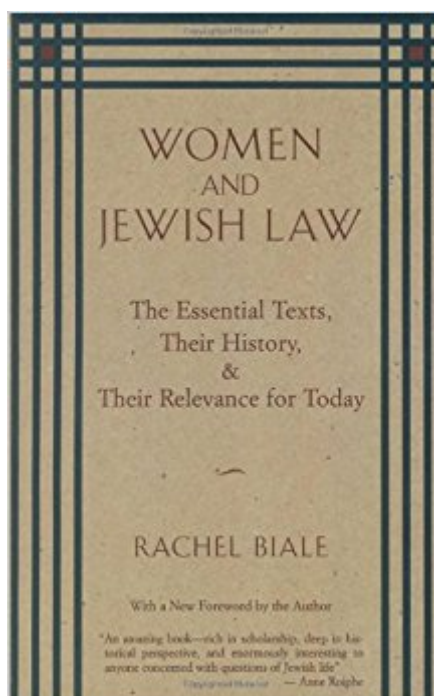


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Women And Jewish Law: The Essential Texts, Their History, And Their Relevance For Today
