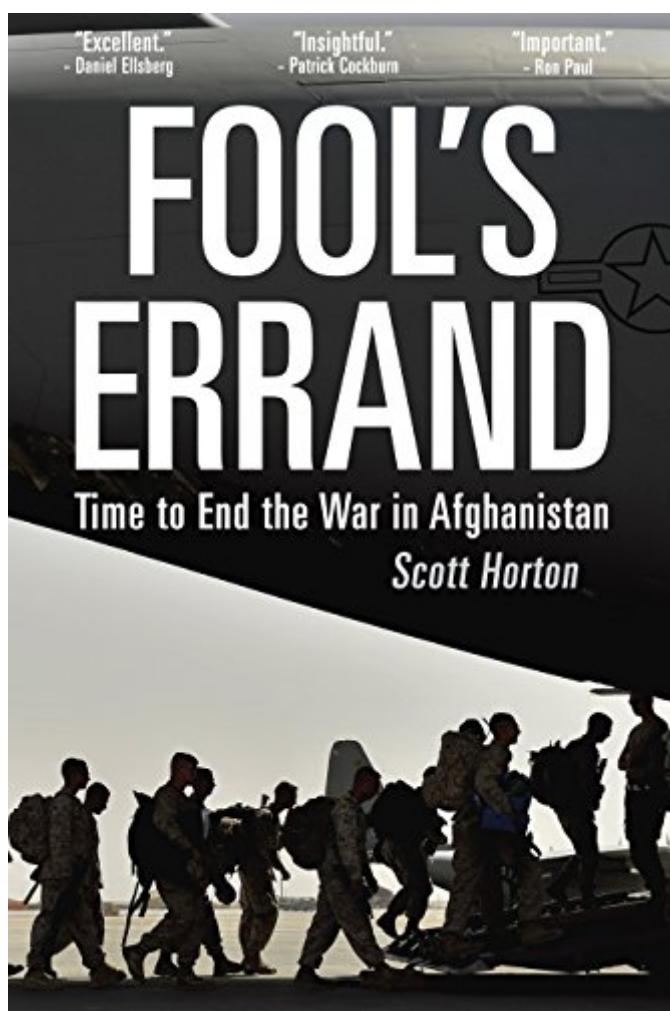

This is an important read - the longest war in US history. Horton's book is an up date of the Canadian journalist Eric Margolis' "War at the top of the world". The US cannot win, and occupation is impossible. Out now.

Horton does an excellent job spelling out exactly why the Afghan war didn't need to happen, why we can't win it, and why the only sensible thing to do is to pull up stakes and leave. Buy a copy for yourself to read, then send copies to your members of Congress.

Scott Horton's writing style is direct, but packed so full of meticulous detail that I often had to read things twice or more to absorb everything said. I don't know of anyone with a greater command of the material he presents here. The conclusions he draws are supported with overwhelming amounts of evidence and scrupulous detail. The case he makes is air tight. Foreign policy staffs all across the political spectrum in Washington need to read this book.

This book has so much information. What little I knew about the Afghan war I learned from the news. I didn't even know what I didn't know until I got into this book. The book is dense, but a fairly easy read, though I took my time to let the information absorb since so much of the history of the war was new to me. I'd recommend this book to anyone whatever their political beliefs, whether you're a small government conservative or an antiwar democrat. The author's knowledge of this war is extraordinary and his analysis seemed spot on to me.

Scott Horton does a phenomenal job outlining failure after failure of US & NATO involvement in this excellently sourced history of America and Afghanistan, the graveyard of empires. A must read for people who want to understand the consequences of US foreign policy.

Scott Horton provides the reader with a very comprehensive yet approachable record of the war in Afghanistan. The footnotes and extensive citation of sources is really impressive, it's as if Scott has been following this conflict for longer than the most recent news cycle.
