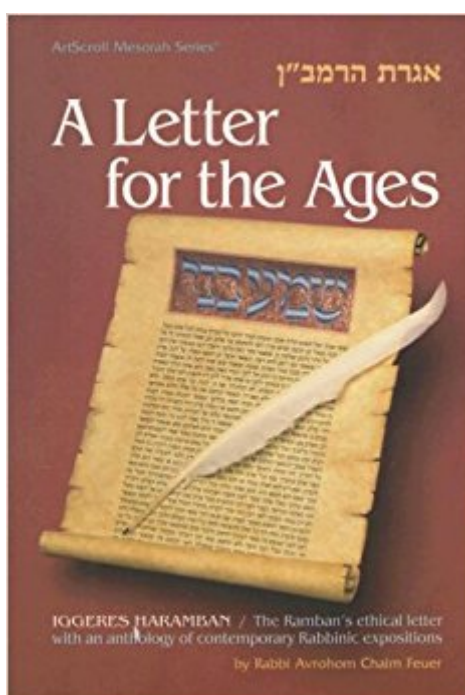


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A Letter For The Ages: Iggeres Haramban: The Ramban's Ethical Letter With An Anthology Of Contemporary Rabbinic Expositions.
