

Well written, witty and mostly fast paced, it draws the reader into the planning and execution of the biggest coup in betting history, as well as the why of it and the fascinating characters it brought together. What Barney Curley did was akin to working a 3D jigsaw puzzle with moving pieces in its complexity and sheer audacity.
