A great sci-fi story about discovering a mystery about a ship and stopping a war. The character development was well done and Tah and Alpha are favorites. If you like sci-fi, you'll love this book! I love the authors other series, The Tide, and was not disappointed in the least! Can't recommend enough.

This is a good story about a medical officer that is the last survivor of a spacecraft from Earth. They had been sent on a mission from a larger fleet of ships. They are expected to go to a remote planet in another solar system, with their mid sized cruiser, to pick up a scientist left to interface with a new race of aliens. Their ship is attacked and quickly overwhelmed by a vicious alien race with higher levels of technology and a much more aggressive nature. The medical officer, Tag Brewer, has to survive, kill the remaining boarding aliens, escape from their attacking spacecraft, warn the earth of a new war with an alien race and still pick up the scientist planet side. This is not an easy task when your out gunned, out numbered and the only survivor on a massively damaged and crippled spacecraft with no crew. The storyline continues to pick up speed throughout the book and it holds your interest. It is a good initial opening book to a new series and opens the door for a good follow-up story. I like the book and I rated it 5 stars. I can't wait until the next release of the series. This story is interesting and I like the main character. I found it interesting how the main character was constantly challenged and his life was in jeopardy and yet he was able to develop a plan to survive. He also insisted in saving other lives of those around him and fellow explorers.

To me this is a cross of First Contact, Space Opera and Military Science Fiction genres. As Chief Medical Officer aboard the SRES Argo, Lieutenant Command Tag Brewer's main concern was for the welfare of his crew-mates. He had some training in other areas but nothing to prepare him for the hostile greeting that met the ship's entry into a new solar system. Life as Tag knew it changed dramatically. I really enjoyed reading this book and how the author showed not only the caring nature of Tag but the other emotions that he felt during the course of events that unfolded. Warning: There is violence and some adult language.

Anthony Melchiorri's first installment of this series is a non-stop thrill ride from the very first page when we are introduced to Tag, a medical/science officer on the research vessel Argo. When the ship is attacked by unknown pirates, Tag has to call upon his former officer training in order to save himself and his ship and from there the adventure only picks up steam as Tag and his small band of companions, including one whose origins Tag has a particular responsibility for, attempt to stay alive and also piece together the identity of the pirates and how they fit in to a galactic puzzle. The action goes from space-bound battles to terrestrial chases, leaving the reader barely time to catch a breath. In fact, sometimes the action sequences are so fast and furious that as a reader I longed for some more development of the characters and their relationships, but perhaps there will be more time for that in the next book in the series, as the story is only beginning with this book. On balance I found this to be a great vacation/airplane read that left me wanting to keep reading on the beach and in the hotel room to find out what happens. I want to know more about Tag and Sofia and Corin in order to solve what is still a mystery at the end of book 1. The writing is clear and sufficiently descriptive without losing the pace of the story. I'm looking forward to reading the second installment. Very well done, Mr. Melchiorri.

This book is well-written with a well thought out plot that flows smoothly and keeps the reader completely engrossed. The character development is excellent, so you feel you know them. This is a very entertaining story, which I highly recommend. I will definitely read more books by this author.
