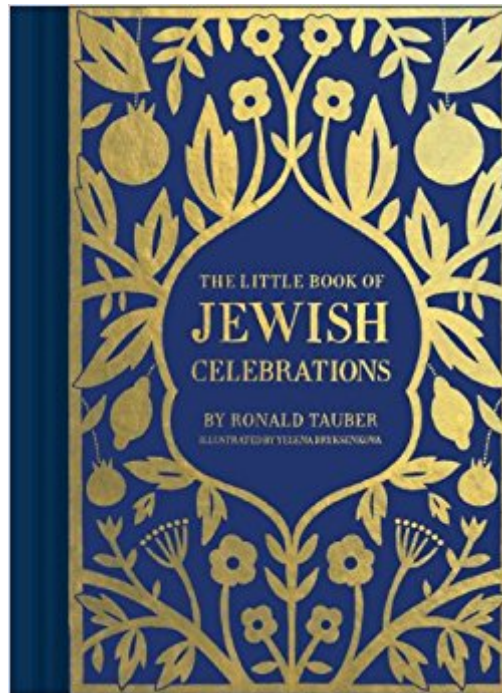

This book is extremely well done. It is particularly helpful to people who may not be of the Jewish faith but who have Jewish family or friends and who would like to know more about Jewish celebrations, customs and holidays. What makes the book interesting is that it discusses particular events in the Jewish calendar providing a discussion about their history, how they are observed and celebrated and providing biblical references along with a discussion of relevant vocabulary. It does this in a compact volume which is richly illustrated and written in an easily readable style.
