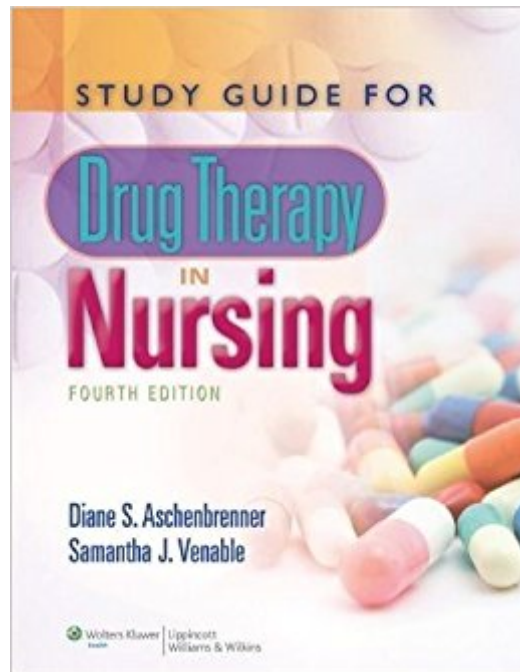




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Study Guide For Drug Therapy In Nursing

Some spelling and grammar errors but a very nice study guide. If you are deciding on whether to purchase the text book or the study guide, I recommend the study guide. It gives you top ten things to know about each chapter, basically a well written summary. And a lot of very helpful multiple choice study questions with answers in the back of the book. - but of course also depends on your professor. Mine gives very detailed lecture notes, that make the text book unnecessary.

I like the variety of formats for review, but am finding mistakes in the book--not a whole lot, which is why it only gets 4 stars. For example: Chapter 12 has a multiple choice question with only one option: "a." The answer in the back of the book says the answer is "b." If you can live with a few of these types of mistakes, go for it. The book has lots of NCLEX-style questions for each chapter review.

This studyguide is a great addition to the book. I love how it enforces the studying of the vocabulary, as crazy as it is basic memorization is usually hardest for me. But give me a process and I've learned it immediately! Definitely recommend this item, because if you're going into nursing or another health care field this is something we need to know!!
