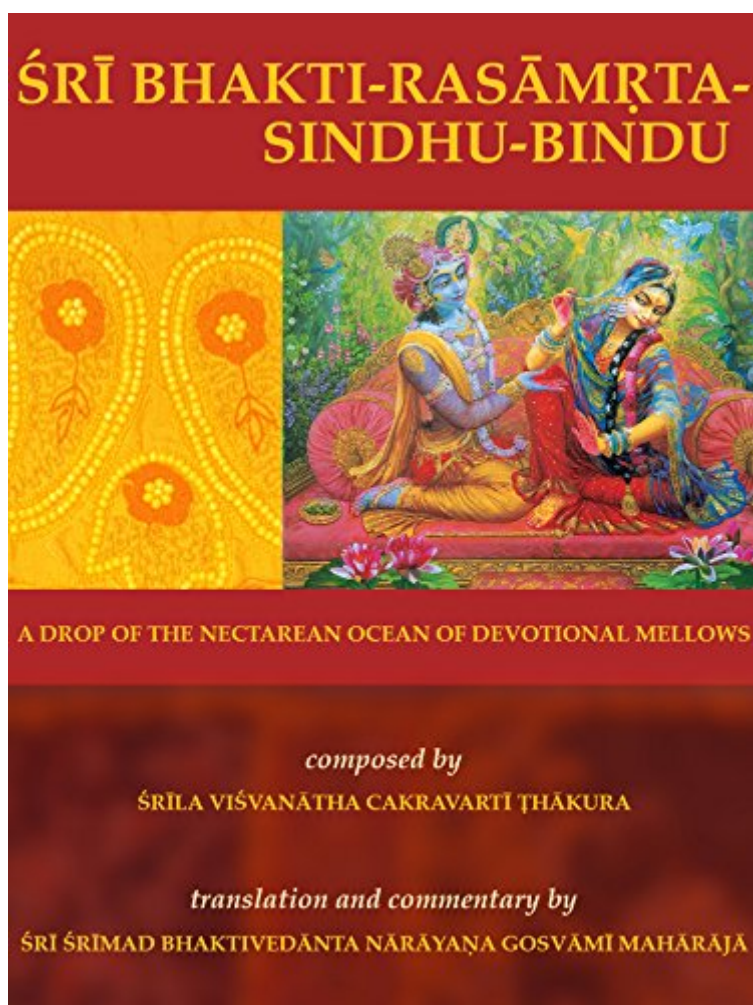


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Bhakti-rasamrta-sindhu-bindu: A Drop Of The Nectarean Ocean Of Devotional Mellows
