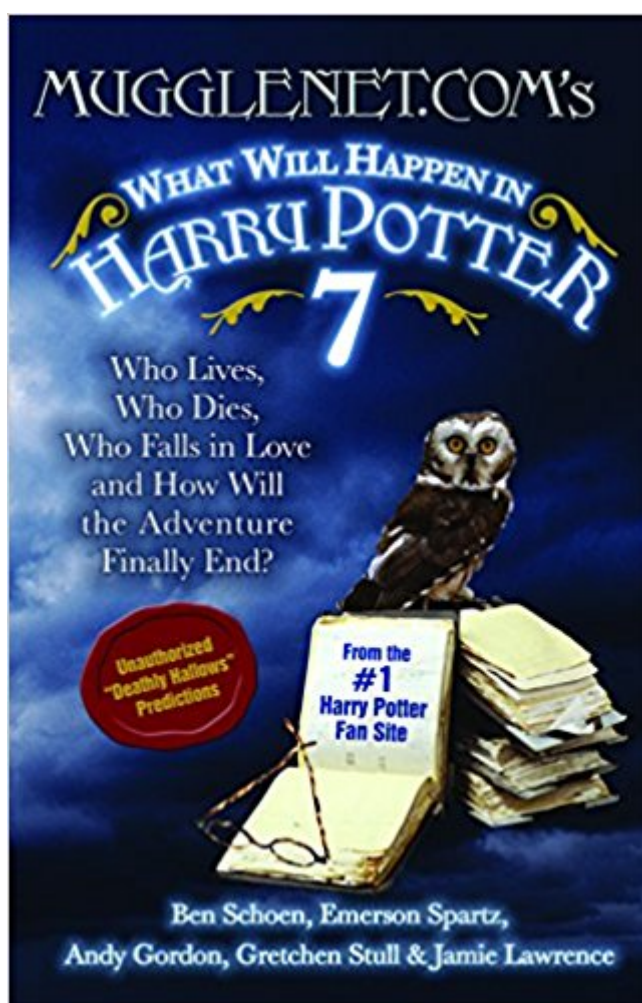

What more can we say. Teenagers who start a Harry Potter fan site that now gets 20 millions hits per month and is so good, popular and famous that J.K. Rowling gives it an award on her personal

website and grants the founder an interview with her (and she doesn't give many interviews).

In 2007, Harry Potter fever was in full swing. The fifth movie was about to come out, and the book series was drawing to a close with the seventh book inching closer to release on July 21st, 2007. In the anticipation, fans went rabbid trying to scroung up every bit of information they could about the then-forthcoming seventh and final tome in the beloved series. Books such as this one cropped up everywhere, fueling the speculative fires about the mysteries to be solved by predicting the possible outcomes for the characters we came to know and love. On July 21st, 2007, this particular book and all others like it instantly became irrelevant. That said, there is something still alluring about books like this, even going on a decade later. I skipped this book the first time around, and happened across it by chance when purchasing a copy of the series for my brother. I figured it might be fun to look back and see just how accurate some of these predictions were, what was way off the mark, and even ponder the could-have-beens. Surprisingly, as far as this book goes, quite a bit of it was spot-on. Obviously, don't come in expecting to find any mind-blowing revelations about a book nearly ten years old. All the information is way out-dated and at this point, the book is nothing more than an odd curiosity for fans who skipped it the first time around. The only real joy you could get from it now is looking to see just how accurate these "predictions" really were. And on that, this is a good time-waster.

If you're like me, you are reading these reviews in order to see whether it is worth your money/while to read this book. Also, I assume you wouldn't be researching this book if you didn't have more than a casual interest in the Harry Potter Series. If you want a book that prepares you for the upcoming release of the 7th Harry Potter Book, then I can recommend this as an excellent read. It is well written and well organized. I don't always agree with all of their conclusions, but intelligent speculation is exactly what one is looking for in a book like this. One thing I really liked was that they didn't pursue ridiculously speculative solutions to the Harry Potter Series. If I had one quibble, it is that sometimes they treat their inferences and conclusions as facts and then use them to venture into new areas. But it's nitpicking. If you don't take a stand with a book like this it just becomes a bunch of unsatisfying "could be", "might be", "in my opinion" wishy-washy mush. On the whole I think they did a very good job of seeking facts from the books and from J.K. Rowling interviews, extrapolating intelligent inferences from those facts and then drawing reasoned conclusions. You don't really expect a book like this to get all of it's predictions right. The purpose of a book like this is to add pleasure to the reading of the upcoming Deathly Hallows by allowing one to observe clues one

might have otherwise overlooked and to better make reasoned analysis of the book as it unfolds. I gave this book five stars. I would normally only give it 4 stars because I think it was a very good book, but not one of the greats. But in its niche - which is analysis of book 7 of the Harry Potter series - I doubt you can hope for anything better researched, thought through or clearly written as this. Thus the 5 stars. Good reading!

Loved this book: really great theories and speculations. DO NOT read if you have not read all of the Harry Potter books, because it contains MAJOR SPOILERS. I give it 4 out of 5 stars because although it's an excellent book and very well-written, it does seem to veer towards other theories more than others (e.g. Harry is a Horcrux, R.A.B. is Regulus Black, etc.). And even though it gives genuinely plausible theories for both sides (besides the Snape is good/bad issue), it doesn't say, "We believe that Harry is a Horcrux." It says, "Harry is a Horcrux." So if the book was a little less adamant about certain things, I would have given it 5 stars; but it's still a great book nonetheless.

While only JKR really knows what happens in book 7, this book does a great job of covering many of the possibilities. I liked the fact that they presented two sides (no Harry won't die/ yes he will, Etc.) and had good supporting evidence for each view. Definitely a must read while we wait for the OOP movie and of course the final book!

It's a good book, decent way to blow some time while waiting for book seven... but pretty much any theory here can be read in the Editorials on Mugglenet's site for free. However, they thread them together in the book so it works a little differently. I'd recommend it.
