

In 1976 he joined the faculty at Miami University, where he is currently Professor of Geography. Besides teaching courses on Urban and Human Geography and writing textbooks, Dr. Rubenstein also conducts research in the automotive industry and has published two books on the subject entitled *The Changing U.S. Auto Industry: A Geographical Analysis* (Routledge) and *Making and Selling Cars: Innovation and Change in the U.S. Auto Industry*
