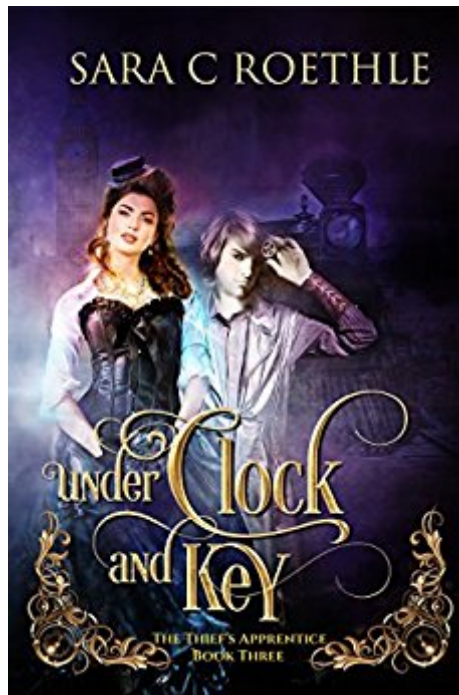




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Under Clock And Key (The Thief's Apprentice Book 3)
