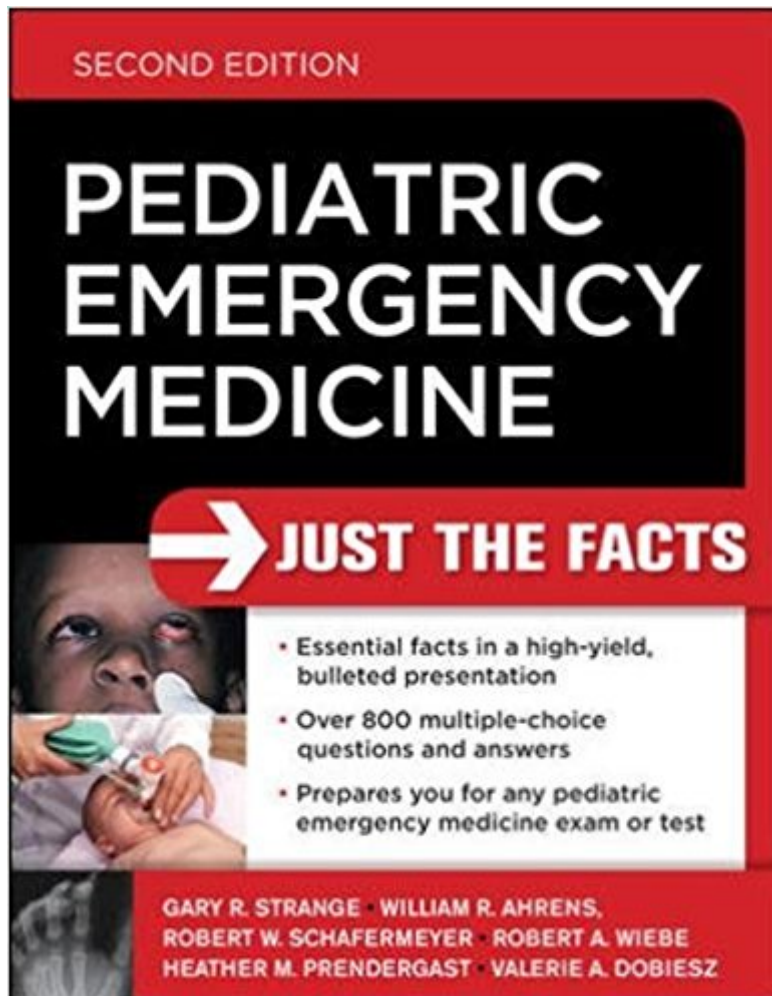

I was rather disappointed by this version of the textbook given the second edition should be better than the first edition. The text has more chapters. However, the quality of the written chapters and end-of-chapter questions is poor. I wished that the questions were reviewed by the editors to assess
