

# Supernatural Psychology: Roads Less Traveled



## Synopsis

A fascinating analysis of the psychology behind the popular TV series *Supernatural*. From Travis Langley (Batman and Psychology; The Walking Dead Psychology; Game of Thrones Psychology) and Lynn S. Zubernis (Family Don't End with Blood; Fan Phenomena: *Supernatural*).
