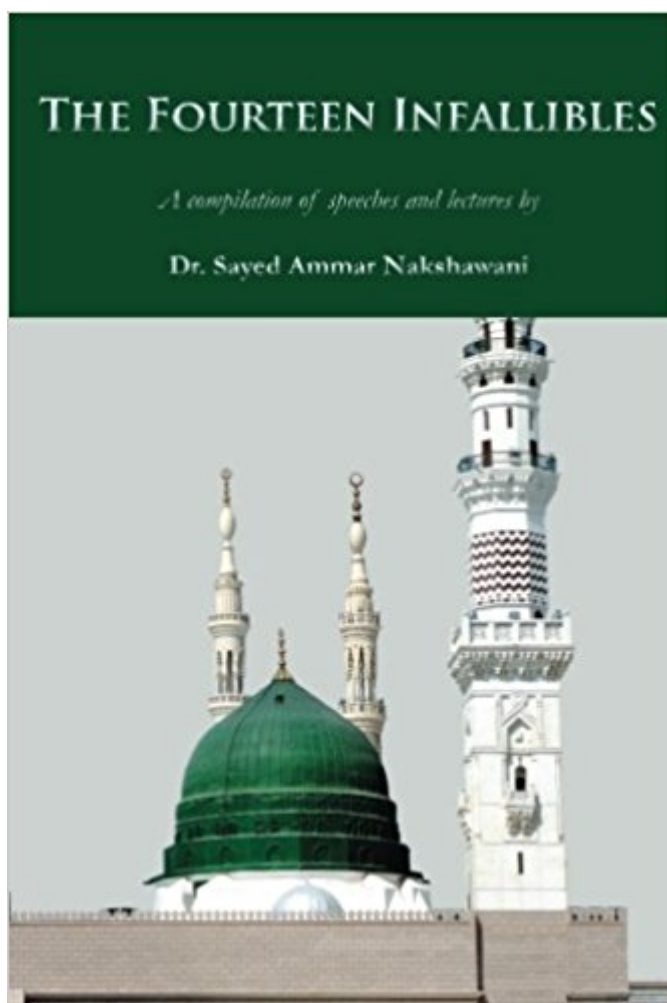

The Holy Prophet of Islam occupies a prominent position within the religion of Islam and is revered as the greatest personality within the religion. He is a man whose life has to be examined in depth for there are many lessons to be learnt and indeed many examples to be derived. And he is indeed a man whose biography has been unfortunately very much undervalued and indeed very much

underestimated. Therefore it is vital that we discuss his biography from the day that he was born until the day he died in order that we are able to, firstly, take as many practical lessons from his life and apply them in our own lives; and secondly, remove any misconceptions that surround his biography, for there was a period in Medieval Europe when he was seen as being the devil incarnate or as being the false Messiah, the Antichrist. Therefore, there is a need for us to examine his biography so that we present him in his true light - as a mercy for mankind and a moral exemplar for everyone.
