

Volume 2 of a trilogy continues to build momentum. Compton and his remaining fleet have left Earth 2 and continue to transit via warp gates further and further into First Imperium space. Stopping occasionally to explore planets that are uninhabited and are rotting away. Where did the population go ? The material in the ruins still shine as if brand new yet the ruins shout thousands of years of decay ? Even further away from Earth 2 the ruins are showing signs of battles. Tremendous battles and they trip a hidden alarm sending Imperium battle bots against the landed crew. The First Imperium Regent (computer) has found them and plots how to defeat this pesky species. Discovery ? Battles ? Alliances ? leads us towards the conclusion in volume 3. For those who enjoy Military Science Fiction (Halo, Lost Fleet, Dietz Old Man Series) this is another Author in that genre that EXCELS at story telling. **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**

He hopes to land a contingent of scientists and marines to raise food and study the ruins of major cities left behind by the Imperium while he moves the diminished fleet through several gates hoping against hope to remain unnoticed long enough to replace stores and possibly discover something in the ruins to aid in their defense.
