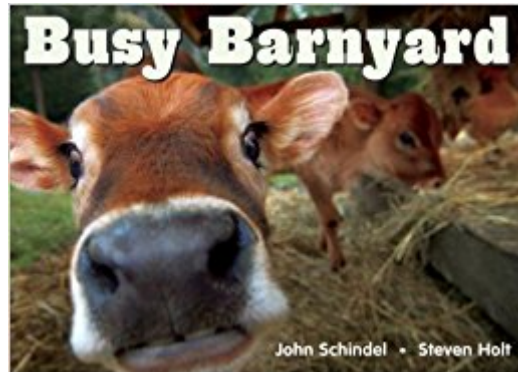

The penguin book is the best but others are also cute. Very durable board books with real photos of animals doing all sorts of things. The words rhyme and are not more advanced words that you expect in a boardbook, but I think it's good for them to hear different sounds, so I like that. These are a good value set.

I have purchased several of the books from this series and every one of them has been excellent. A great addition to any toddler library. Real photographs are so much more meaningful to very young children and these are clear, vibrant, lend themselves to lots of conversation about what we're looking at in the photo.
