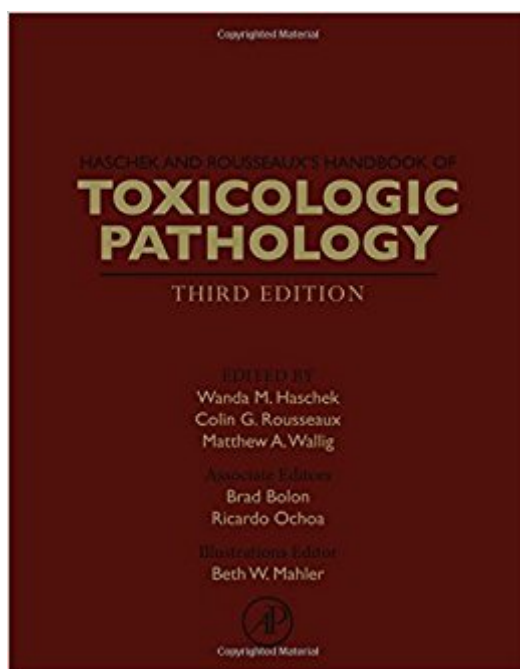


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Haschek And Rousseaux's Handbook Of Toxicologic Pathology, Third Edition

He has described, investigated, and evaluated numerous toxicologic pathology issues associated with pharmaceutical, pesticides, and agrochemicals. He has served on the editorial board of Toxicologic Pathology. He is a former president of the Society of Toxicologic Pathology.Professor Wallig is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists. He is Professor Emeritus in the Department of Pathobiology, College of Veterinary Medicine, the Department of Food Science and Human Nutrition, as well as the Division of Nutritional Sciences at the University of Illinois. His research has focused on the chemoprotective properties and mechanisms of phytochemicals in the diet, in particular those in cruciferous vegetables and soy, and the pathophysiology of pancreatic injury.
