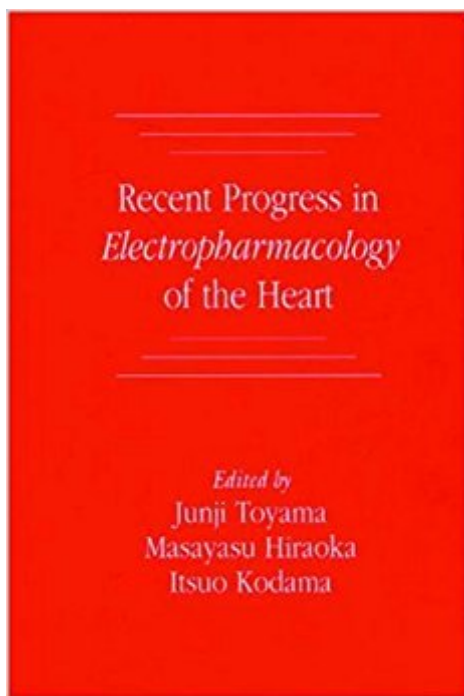


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Recent Progress In Electropharmacology Of The Heart

This book contains proceedings of the International Satellite Symposium of the 59th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japanese Circulation Society held in April, 1995 in Nagoya, Japan. The symposium integrates the widespread recent advances on the electropharmacology of the heart from single channels to human patients.
