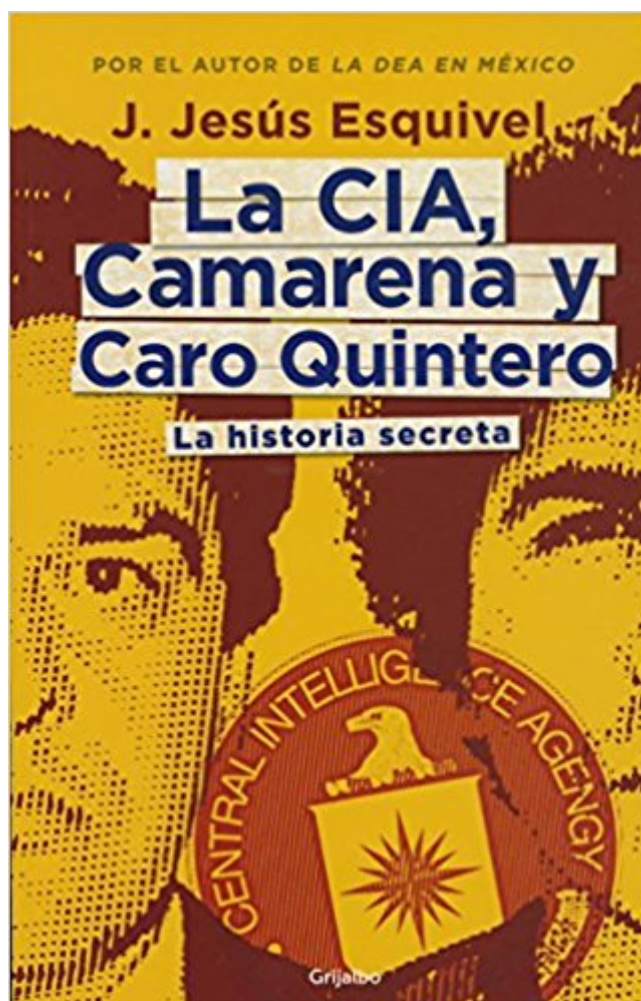

The Esquivel's basic thesis is that the Mexican narcos killed Camarena under CIA orders or at least, with a green light from them. While some can regard this as ridiculous -or outrageous-, it makes perfectly sense if you are familiar with the Iran-Contra affair or the agency's covert operations during the Vietnam War.
