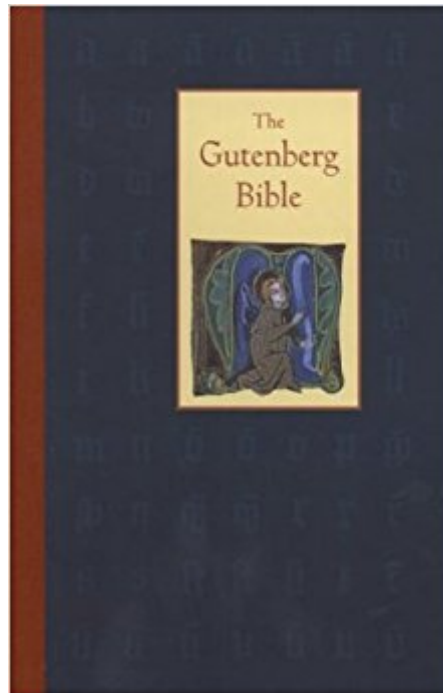

The author also discusses Henry Huntington's purchase of the Bible in 1911 for the then-unimaginable sum of \$50,000.
