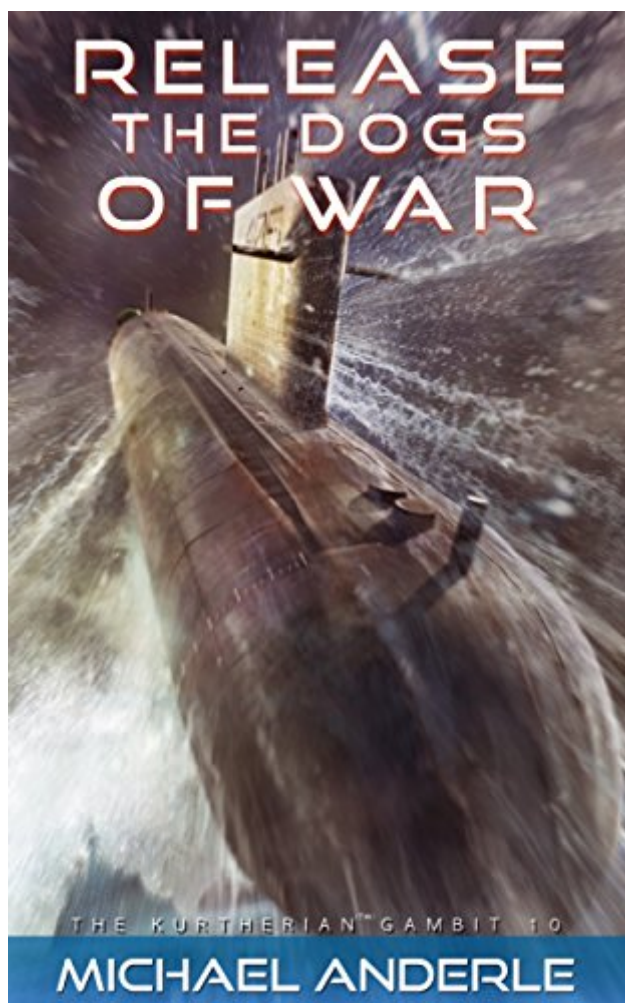


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Release The Dogs Of War (The Kurtherian Gambit Book 10)

Hats off to Michael and team. This is becoming a great series of interlinked and related stories. Can't read the next one yet as I have to work in 5 hours. You are filling out the characters and making them more realistic as each story goes. I appreciate the way you introduce new situations with the other storyline. Keeps you on your toes. Being a technical writer and married to a schoolteacher, the only criticisms I have is about some grammatical errors and sometimes seeing a partial sentence released twice. But these are minor issues and not related to the overall enjoyment of reading about Bethany Ann and her "bitches". Keep up the good work. Can't wait for the next iteration.

Ran across the Rise of Magic series and was intrigued, so decided to purchase all 16 books in the Kurtherian Gambit series. I then spent the next 4 days reading all 16 of them, then moving on to the Second Dark Ages and Trials and Tribulations series. This book in the series really starts moving things into Bethany Ann's main mission. She's working with the U.S. President, the bad guy aliens have put in an appearance, and she is on the verge of having a fully operational space battle ship. As if that isn't enough, the ladies are match making, Barnabas and Tabitha step up into new kick ass roles, and even the Illuminati are in for some just deserts.I don't think I'll ever cease to be amazed at the way Michael Anderle manages to take a whole lot of little pieces and weave them throughout a story until everything comes together and leaves you with a big picture that just makes sense. I was a little lost in the technical descriptions, but then realized it's because they are realistically accurate, and just happen to be more than a bit beyond what my head can easily wrap around. That's got to be pure joy for the science and tech wonks. I like that he doesn't dumb things down in order to go easy on some of us.

Hmmmmm, a review after reading 10 books in the series. First, I'd like to say that I'm an "old guy" from 1946, who has been reading SF since his pre-teens, hiding under the covers with a flashlight and listening for the sound of footsteps and door handles turning, so I could drop everything and do the "face of sleeping innocence," until the interruption went away and I could get back to "business." Second, I am NOT a particular fan of Vampire fiction, even though I've been "snagged" a few times,

so I bought the first "bundle" of the series, but postponed reading for some months! Third, I have now become series addict (and I teach in the Addiction Science Specialties area of a university in Korea). I

Bethany Anne adds a new group to her kickass followers. She already has the Queen's Own, the Queen's Guardians, and the Queen's Elite, now she has a new force for justice. And wait until you see who is in it! And what is going on with the women? What was said in the top-secret females-only meeting? There is less bloody action than I expected from the build-up in the previous book, but the point is made that this is due to BA coming into her own in her new role. Her followers deserve a just leader, not the bloodthirsty avenger she longs to be. That doesn't mean that the ones responsible for Michael's death get away with it. I greatly enjoy this book and series. The books are a little short, but arrive quickly. Recommended.

Raced through the story, cause how can you not? It was good, but not the emotional rollercoaster of #9. I see the need for exposition to show how you get from A to B, but I think the emotions from Bitches Night Out was needed in this book to push into the tenor I expect from these stories. Keeping the momentum and emotional tone going throughout the series has got to be hard so I appreciate the craftsmanship that Anderle puts into each book. Looking forward to the next installment.

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
