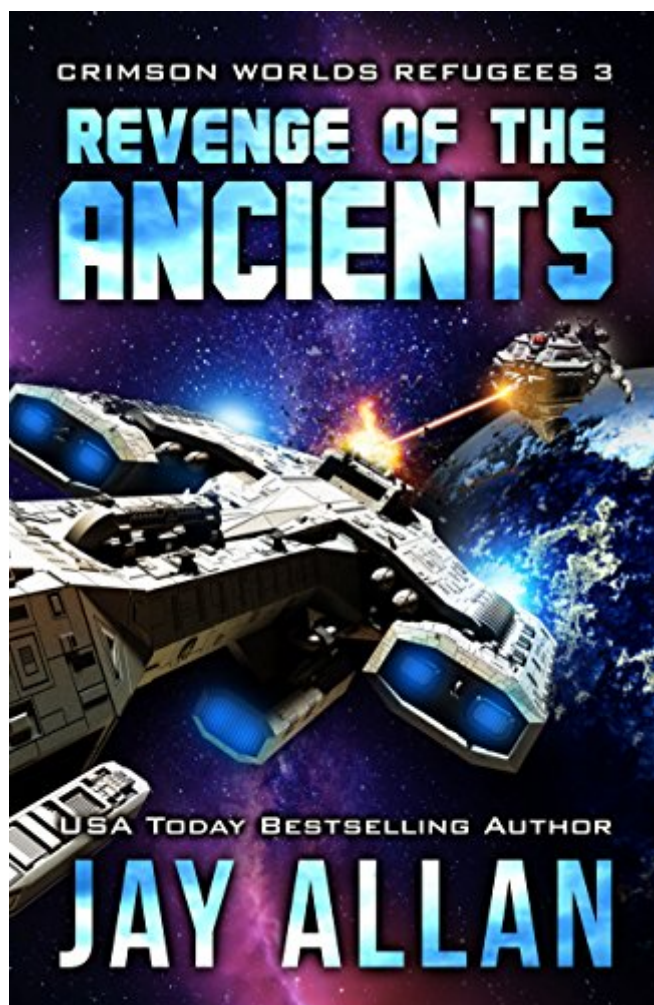

Terrance Compton and the survivors of Earth Force are still trapped behind enemy lines after the X2 warp gate had been destroyed. They are trying to make it to the world created for them by the Ancients. That world is the heritage left to them by the First Imperium. Any return to Earth is out of the question. They are relentlessly pursued by the military forces and robot spacecraft of the Regent super computer that wants only one thing. It wants all humans to die. Jay Allan writes some of the best military Sci-Fi that I have ever read. I have purchased and read most of his books and this one is one of the best. It is full of action and strategy and technology that I enjoy reading. The book is fast paced and I could not put it down. Since this is a series you get to know the characters in the story and learn to love them or hate them. The story continues to take them through their lives and struggles for survival against a more powerful and relentless enemy. I have not enjoyed reading Sci-Fi as much since my youth and the reading of the books by Robert Heinlein. Jay Allan is a rising superstar Sci-Fi writer IMHO. This is a very good book and if you love military Sci-Fi then I recommend that you read the entire series of stories. This is five stars for me.

I thought this was going to be a trilogy but apparently there's more coming. Should be interesting to see if the story holds up. Revenge of the Ancients was pretty much what I expected. The fight for survival, ships and key characters being lost - sacrificed to save the fleet. All that kind of stuff. I won't mention names - no spoilers. I felt a bit let down by the ending of this book. But I guess that's why the series continues.

What a great 3rd book in this series. The combat is so intense, and you get so invested in the characters. I tell you the combat scenes are so great and you get so into the story and characters, especially in this third book in this series (and, of course, I also bought and read the other two). I found myself on the verge of tears more than once. If you are a fan of space military science fiction you will simply love this series, and this third book is nothing short of awesome. Anything that Jay Allan writes I buy and read. I don't write reviews for every one, but this one I simply had to. This might be one I re-read just because I liked the characters so much and how they responded to the

stress of combat, putting their lives on the line so their fellow warriors and humanity could have a chance to survive was very inspiring. Simply, I loved this book.

WOW! I just love this series. Normally I am sick to death of the "lost fleet" theme that so many authors are pumping out, but this one is unique and interesting, and whenever I finish a book in this series I go "wow!". I have read over 20,000 books and this series is one of my favorites. I would recommend this author to anyone and EVERYONE! More more more, please!

This is some of the best military sci-fi I have read in a long time. In fact, the whole Crimson Worlds series is the best military sci-fi series I have ever read. The action is non-stop and the characters are well developed. I can't wait for the next book to be released. Jay Allan is truly one of my favorite authors.

The plot of this story and of the series is interesting but the author is milking it for all it's worth. The repetition was to the point of insulting with, for example, over 20 instances of people feeling admiration for Admiral Compton and 10 instances of how brilliant the scientist Cutter is. The emotions and some of the dialogue was also ridiculously over the top. I was glad to reach the end of this book (as I said, the plot is good) but I'm glad the torture is over. I will not buy any of this author's books again.

A fine story and great ending to the series. But wait...is it? This book is worthy of my 5 star rating up to the very end. BUT THEN, there appears an epilogue. Why Mr. Allan did you have to do that? The purist in me wants to knock off one or two stars for what you did. Okay, enough venting. As I said a great story. Admiral Compton and the fleet make it to Earth 2 each in their own good time with plenty of action occurring all over the place. Some people we have come to love are lost along the way and it hurts. But their sacrifice benefits so many others. Thanks for a great ride!

My only complaint so far with this series is the FACT that Tritium is NOT found entrapped by planets. Tritium has a half life of less than 13 minutes. It is not naturally occurring and could never be found in quantities for use for any other kind of energy or weapons purposes. It must be created. That said, the Helium 3 CAN be used as a source of Tritium, once it gets exposed to the right energy neutrons. The story line is interesting overall.
